

MV Communications District Technician Job Description

Job Summary

Successful applicant will assist with the technical operations of the district. Perform installation, general repair, and maintenance at district mountaintop sites. Sites include towers up to 100 feet. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, equipment operation, remote monitoring, tower maintenance, coaxial cabling and helping subscribers.

Job Responsibilities

Help identify, troubleshoot and fix signal quality issues at remote sites.
Coordinate with outside providers to determine source of outages.
Assist subscribers with reception problems.

Qualifications

Basic electronics experience
Knowledge or ability to learn analog and digital television fundamentals and IP-based networks.
Must be able to safely climb ladders and/or towers up to 100 feet to maintain equipment.
Must have a valid driver's license and clean driving record.
Experience in operating 4 wheel drive vehicles on primitive roads, sometimes with a trailer loaded with a tracked snow machine.
Able to respond on short notice.
Able to improvise solutions if necessary to return service.
Must be able to bend, lift, and carry up to 50 pounds.
A "can do" attitude, the ability to work flexible hours and good interpersonal skills are required.
